AACSB's Confidentiality and Data Protection Policy

Implemented in May, 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a framework designed to give EU citizens more control and protection over their personal data. As a result of this regulation, AACSB implemented a policy for its accreditation volunteers to follow, including peer review team members, mentors, and accreditation committee members. Since these roles are provided access to accreditation reports which may contain personal data of individuals, individuals serving in this capacity are required to sign annually AACSB's new [Confidentiality and Data Protection Policy](#). This policy addresses the ownership and treatment of documentation containing personal data, as well as procedures for addressing potential breaches in confidentiality. All accreditation volunteers will be sent an email once per year including the policy and a request for an electronic signature. AACSB is committed to importance of the privacy of our members.
